

# Public Transport Services

MacKillop Catholic College is accessible by a range of school and public bus services.

For students living in:

*Please note:* Services may be direct or require a transfer at an interchange.

## Fares

Students are eligible for a child student fare until the end of the year in which they turn 18. Child students pay a flat fare regardless of the distance travelled.

Fares are currently halved until 1 July 2026. This means a single trip ticket paid with cash costs \$1.00, and a 10-trip ticket (discounted by 20%) costs \$8.00.

## Greencard

Students can use an electronic Greencard on Metro and Tassielink bus services. A Greencard stores travel credit, can be topped up online, and offers a 20% discount and free transfers within 90 minutes of the first boarding.

## Student Bus Pass for Free Travel

Student Bus Passes allow students to travel for free for all or part of the journey from home to school and return.

You may be eligible if you hold a government concession card, travel on more than one fare charging bus service, or are under a Care and Protection Order.
